Cal Trout's Shasta Springs Trout Camp is located on 40 acres in the famed Upper Sacramento River Canyon; nestled along a remote, lightly fished stretch of the river between Dunsmuir and Cantara Loop. The Camp is comfortably equipped with three sleeping cabins (two per cabin, sleeping bags required), outdoor kitchen, outdoor shower, and fire pit. Cal Trout host and guide, Craig Ballenger, will prepare all your meals and guide your party.

All food and non-alcoholic beverages will be provided. The camp can accommodate up to six guests. This trip, for three days and two nights, must be scheduled Monday through Thursday. The camp typically opens in May and runs through the end of October.
